This week, we had the zechus to sit down with co-founder; Moshe Yosef Levy and co-founder; Yechiel of Siyum Yomi. Siyum Yomi is a revolutionary program started with one goal in mind, which is to unite klal yisroel through limud mishnayos. It's an honor and privilege to have them join us.

Q: How was Siyum Yomi started?

SY: We had been learning mishnayos for people in the neighborhood who were just niftar. Like in most communities, we had different men in the community taking upon themselves a masechta to be finished by the end of the month. We thought to ourselves,

why wait one month if this is something that can be finished daily? By having thousands of yidden learning a different mishna daily, we can make this dream a reality.

Between the 2 of us, we have immediate family members who have been involved in the past and some current members of Chevra Hatzolah, founder of a local Tomchei Shabbos pantry feeding over 400 families weekly, and involved in the success of starting many successful organizations. We feel the need and urge to do more for our community.

As cousins, we are stepping into the shoes which were prepared for us by our distinguished families, and doing what they've always done – to help and go above and beyond what's needed, in order to help and unite our community.

Q: How did you turn your dream into a reality?

SY: Right away, we reached out to many of Klal Yisroel's rabbanim and speakers who enthusiastically gave us positive haskamos.

We reached out to Rabbi Benzion Klatzko, who is now the Siyum Yomi advisor and together with his team at Shabbat.com has played a major role into what Siyum Yomi is today. We saw such great feedback and realized the need for something like this, we immediately created a hi-tech website and hotline, thereby enabling anyone and everyone to reserve a mishna.

Q: So, How do the logistics of the program work?

SY: Each month, every member of Klal Yisroel has the ability to take a Mishna on either of our platforms to be recited each day of the month, and together with over 4,000 other yidden a Siyum mishnayos will be made every single day. A week or two before every rosh chodesh, the system will be reset, enabling people to choose a Mishna for the next month.

Q: What else do you offer?

SY: Additionally, we are working on

many other projects to be released in the near future. We have also partnered with Torah Anytime, Chazaq, Stories to Inspire and the talisman to produce events with meaningful content from well-known rabbanim and speakers over the years. Recent events include the shloshim of Rav Zecharia Wallerstein zt"l and Rav Chaim Kanievsky zt"l. They can be viewed at Siyumyomi.org

Q: How can one get more involved?

SY: Aside from taking a Mishna, and enabling us to have a complete Siyum. One can be koneh the zechus of a Siyum (one day) for only \$100, or a full month of daily siyumim for \$1,500. For additional sponsorship opportunities please email info@siyumyomi.org
